












The Faculty of Management Sciences,






PSU PHARMACY STORE

SRI TRANG RESERVOIR PSU





It also provides a fitness center, Olympic-size swimming pool, and fully-equipped gymnasiums.




PSU BIZ MALL

GREENWAY NIGHT MARKET AND ASEAN NIGHT BAZAAR






Greenway Night Market and ASEAN Night Bazaar are the flea market, mostly are clothes and accessories. Also, there is a food center at Greenway Night Market.

HOW TO GET PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Hat Yai has various types of public transportation e.g. Tuk Tuk, Songthaew, and motorcycle taxi. Mainly, you can get those transport in front of the PSU main gate or Songklanagarind Hospital. Normally, you can get Tuk Tuk and motorcycle taxi near the Rong Chang cafeteria.



Tuk Tuks are all around Hat Yai. You can negotiate with the driver, if you want to go outside the town. Going within the city may costs 20–100 Baht. The price will be cheaper if you go with your friends groups, can be negotiated.

Songthaew is a pick-up truck with two rows seat and have buzzer to press when you want to get off. It is also all around Hat Yai, people usually get Songthaew to go around the city because it has several routes and cheap price. It may costs 10-40 Baht per person.

Motorcycle taxi

Motorbike taxis are abundant in Hat Yai as well. It may costs 20–100 Baht per person, depends on the distance. Normally, if you go to a place nearby the campus, the price is about 30–40 Baht. Also, You can negotiate with the driver, if you want to go outside the town.






FOLLOWING THE DMHTT MEASURES

D: DISTANCING

Maintain social distance and avoid close contact with others. Gathering should be avoided.



M: MASK WEARING

Wear a face mask when going outside and with other people



H: HAND WASHING

Keep washing your hands with soap or alcohol-based gel, which contains at least 70% of alcohol.



T: TESTING

Test Covid-19 when you have fever symptoms and contact with infected people.



T: THAI CHANA

Scan QR code on Thai Chana app to check-in and out at public venues such as malls and offices











PLACES TO GET TESTED FOR COVID-19

 Self-test with Antigen Test Kit, you can buy ATK at the pharmacy shop nearby. The price is around 80– 150 Baht.



- Get RT-PCR test or Rapid Antigen Test at the hospital, have costs.
- If you got a positive ATK, the hospital requires you to get an RT-PCR test before treatment.

COVID-19 MEASURES FOR HIGH-RISK PEOPLE

from the Centre for the Administration of the Situation due to the Outbreak of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)

• If you get a negative Covid-19 result, but seem have symptoms.

You need to take another ATK test and consider the risk from your previous close people.

• In case of high risk, you have closed to an infected person.

You need to do self-quarantine and self-monitoring for 7 days.

You need to get 1st round of ATK tests after 5 days of quarantine then do the 2nd round test on day 10.

- If you got positive result, call 1330 then you will get home-isolation treatment.
- If you do not have any history of close contact with the infected person, no need to do self-quarantine.


